

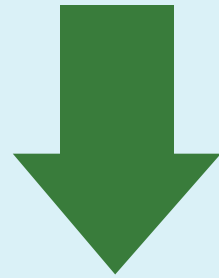


Higher Exam Scores on ABIM MOC Exams means

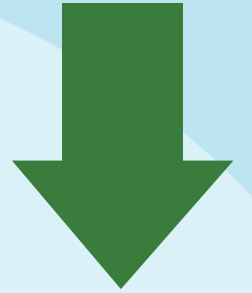

Physicians who score high on the diagnostic questions on their ABIM MOC exam had a 35% lower risk of all-cause mortality for patients at risk for diagnostic error.¹

HOSPITALIZATION

Physicians who score high on the diagnostic questions on an ABIM MOC exam had a 31% lower risk of hospitalization and 30% lower risk of ED visits for one of 13 commonly misdiagnosed conditions.¹
